OFFICIAL OPENING OF BRIT COLLEGE LIMEHOUSE CAMPUS

Jim Fitzpatrick, the MP for Limehouse and Poplar, and a host of dignitaries from industry, commerce and education are helping Brit College mark the opening of its picturesque new campus with a formal ceremony.

On Friday 7th June, students and staff from the College will join with their guests to celebrate the opening of the new Limehouse campus on the banks of the Regents Canal. The Limehouse campus is a purpose built higher education and training facility which represents a major investment in the education infrastructure by Brit College.

Brit College is an independent education provider and has actually been operating since 2006. It has been offering accredited post and undergraduate courses including Business, IT and Law to international students and over 5000 students have benefited from our courses. Many of these are returning for this special event.

As part of its strategic development it is expanded into widening access to education for many underrepresented groups. The College now offers new vocational education and training, enterprise and employability programmes. These include confidence building and employa-

Congratulations to Brit College students who successfully completed Edexcel HND in Business (Management) and Extended Diploma in Strategic Management and Leadership this academic year. 


Moodle VLE

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
